We've foolishly been deceived into trusting the world; a world where the evil one uses his minions to make us blind to sin disguised as what we think we deserve or have the freedom to do.

"I once was lost, but now am found; Was blind, but now I see."

How piercing are the words of "Amazing Grace" to your children who know the truth and the sacrifice you, Jesus, paid for the promise your Father God made to all people long ago, now, and in the years to come. We honor you and you promise to us, Father in Heaven.

So many sense the revival of trust and dependence on you, Almighty and Everlasting God. In our anxiety, with no immunity to a virus, we admit that in big ways or little ways, we had become no different in our temporary blindness than unbelievers. We were stumbling around, convincing ourselves that we'd foolishly believed the glitz of our own doing could be a substitute for you, "The Light of The World." Thank you for light in the darkness of our sin.

With confidence that you're still with us and listening to our prayers, we ask for what the world cannot do without you, Merciful and Gracious God:

-Protect us and provide protection for all your chosen medical caregivers and hospital workers who walk into the buildings, and tents, and ships to be your servants helping all infected patients. Protect first

responders, law enforcement, military personnel and workers in retail stores who are exposed to danger as they report to work around the clock.

- -Guide us to use what we have to help others in even the smallest ways, and give assurance and resources to so many who have found ways they can change direction, making big contributions to the arsenal of defense by providing medical equipment, personal protective equipment, and food for strength and energy.
- -Give wisdom and clear direction to our scientists and researchers as they study what they know today, make changes about what they knew yesterday, and make wise choices for tomorrow.
- -Use your power to change people, Omnipotent God. You know what everyone is thinking, you are present in all places, and you out-power the powerful. We ask you to soften stubborn minds and unwilling hearts in the elected and appointed leaders of our nation and control the influential voices of people who are camped on both sides of the political and ideological fence that divides our nation. Silence criticism and block deceptive attempts that distract from progress toward victory. Open all eyes and align all thinking to see the real enemy they must all fight together. End the war if words they are waging across the fence, and unify their focus on the common concerns for all America's people: the sick and all fighting the sickness, the unemployed and those working far beyond exhaustion, the isolated and those who defy guidelines of separation, the sheltered in place and those without homes or shelter. The people of our nation desperately need unity and common purpose right now, Almighty God, and we acknowledge in this prayer that only you have authority over those in authority.

Lord Jesus, you knew the enemy of your people long ago, and you didn't waste a moment of the time you had left living among your people. You gave us directions for victory, and you warned about the ultimate defeat of stubborn unbelief. Give each of us courage to tell someone who doesn't know you about you and up your promise of forgiveness and eternal life. Father God, in Your Son's Name, we ask for your powerful intervention in the hearts, minds, and bodies of each and everyone of your people in our nation.
